- 2) The department organized a one month workshop on the topic entitled as ***Python and its Applications*** in collaboration with **CETPA Infotech. Pvt. Ltd.**, from 12th September to 5th October, 2019. The training given by **Mr. Anil Kumar**, Director, CEPTA Pvt. Ltd. This workshop was very beneficial to our students as an upcoming demand of this trending language in placements and the students had benefitted with the basics knowledge of this skills development software based trending language. **37 students** were participated in this workshop.
