REPORT OF ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED BY UBA (2019-2020)

Poster making competition

UBA along with North East cell of Shaheed Rajguru college of applied sciences for women organized a poster making competition on the theme “Preventing diseases and cleanliness”. Participants were required to submit the posters by 7 February 2020, Friday. The winners were awarded special hampers and e-certificates. The aim of the competition was to motivate students and provide reliable information regarding social distancing and other precautionary measures.

Covid-19: Aid and cooperation by UBA

The following initiatives were taken by the UBA team of Shaheed Rajguru College of Applied Sciences for Women during the COVID crisis:

- Collection and distribution of wheat, rice, pulses, and other necessary eatables among the villagers who are unable to earn their daily wages due to the nationwide lockdown.
- Help in generating e-ration cards for the villagers.
- Helping the para-transport drivers by getting their forms filled to enable them to receive government aid.
- Undertook the initiative to stitch face masks required to prevent droplet infection as there has been an acute shortage of masks.
- Made posters and videos to motivate them and provide reliable information regarding social distancing and other precautionary measures.
- Training the people in making sanitizers and masks, all by themselves, at home with the help of video tutorials.
- Awareness about counseling sessions, so as to take care of mental health, too.

Community support through social media during the lockdown

In the situation of a global pandemic, under the aegis of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA), the UBA team took the initiative to help the villagers via social media by making various awareness groups to provide all the reliable information regarding social distancing and other precautionary measures.

COVID advisory on mask making

UBA team during the primary stage of lockdown undertook the initiative to stitch face masks required to prevent droplet infection when there had been an acute shortage of masks in the college premises for the guards and other workers. Students, as well as faculty, avidly participated in the mask making and home-made masks were distributed.

Battle Against Hunger

On 2nd June 2020, the UBA team in collaboration with Rupaantar under the supervision of mentor Dr. Lakshmi Sarin provided basic food items (raw material) to daily wage workers residing in Dallupura village. Packets of “Food essentials” were distributed while following all norms and rules under social distancing.

Plastic-free campaign

Team UBA visited the adopted villages, where they sensitized people about the single-use plastics and motivated them to boycott plastics and use alternatives instead. Jute bags were also distributed among the villagers.

Stationary distribution

Stationery items were distributed in the adopted villages to increase the eagerness of kids towards studies and skill development.

Tech4Seva Conference

UBA faculty members attended "Tech 4 Seva", a three-day national workshop (10th -12th August 2019), with the motive to provide a platform to— academicians & scientists (who are working towards the development and adaptation of technologies) to showcase their work on socially relevant technologies— voluntary and other social organisations and facilitator organizations that are working with the communities to address the concerns, issues and challenges of people.
