Report of Activities conducted by UBA (2021-2022)

- **Activity 1:- Webinar on Impact of COVID- 19 on Cancer and Post- COVID complications and Palliative Care** - An insightful and eye opening webinar addressing how the covid-19 affects the cancer cells and the patients was organised in collaboration with the Department of Biochemistry. The Speakers were Dr. Survesha Khanna (Founder cum President of Dharamshila Cancer Foundation and Research Centre) and Dr. Pragya Singh (SR Manager of Dharamshila Narayana Superspeciality Hospital).
- **Activity 2 :- Quiz on India and Its Independence** - An online quiz competition was organised under the celebration of “Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav” on the theme “India and Its Independence”. By participating in the quiz, the participants demonstrated their patriotism while also expanding their knowledge.
- **Activity 3:- Open mic on Mental health in Rural India.** -An online open mic competition was held under the celebration of “Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav” on the theme “Mental health and Rural India” in collaboration with Ehsaas- the mental health and awareness society of the college. The competition helped the students to learn more about mental health in rural India and its effects.
- **Activity 4:-Poster making on Traditional and modern methods of rainwater harvesting in rural India** - An online poster making competition was organised under the celebration of “Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav” on the theme “Traditional and modern methods method of rain water harvesting in rural India”. The students were asked to express their ideas through paintings and sketches and were judged and felicitated.
- **Activity 5:- Poster making competition on Mahatma Gandhi and his struggles** - An online poster making competition was organised on the themes, Movements by Mahatma Gandhi that helped in independence of India and Mahatma Gandhi and his struggles. The students showed their talents through their posters also portraying their love towards their motherland.
- **Activity 6:- Panel discussion on legal marriage age raised to 21 years** - An online Panel Discussion was held on the topic “ Raising the legal marriage age of women in India up to 21 years of age”. The eminent speakers were Mr. Adwiteya Grover (Advocate, Punjab and Haryana High Court), Dr. Chayanika Choudhary (Psychiatrist, Guwahati Medical College) and Dr. Janhawi (Assistant Professor, Delhi University).
- **Activity 7:- Extempore competition on sustainable trends** - An online inter-college extempore competition was organised on the theme “Sustainable trends for a responsible citizen”. The competition helped the students to learn more about what sustainability refers to, that is the ability of something to maintain or "sustain" itself over time.
- **Activity 8:- Video making competition on social issues in rural India** - An online video making competition was organised titled “Ideathon” on the theme “Social issue in rural India and its eradication”. The videos of the students who participated in the competition, depicted how the social issues are so important to be addressed for a healthier rural future.
