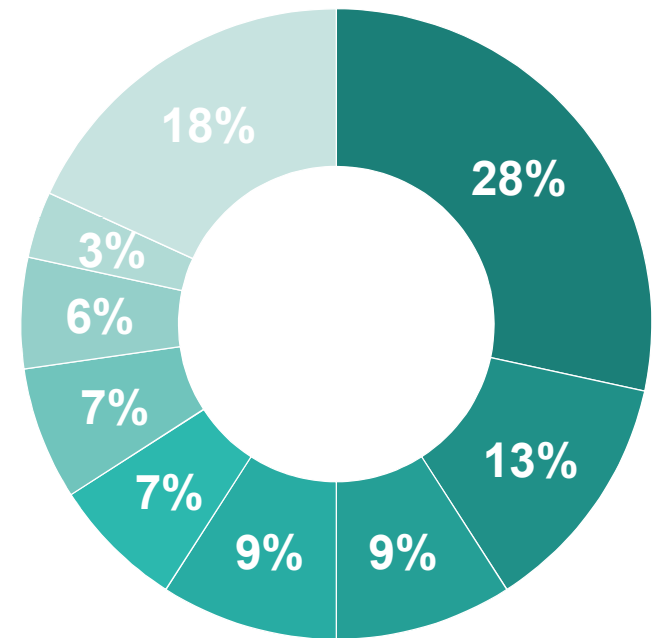

- **Electrical Machine & Control System laboratory** have various equipment's like series and shunt DC Motors, induction motors, etc.
- **Micro-processor & Microcontroller lab** is equipped with 8085 kits to train students for programming and designing new projects.
- **Electronics & Industrial Instrumentation lab** has instruments like orifice meter, DC calibration meter, level transmitter, Ultrasonic flow meter, ratio controller, pressure gauge calibrator, magnetic flow meter, circular chart recorder etc.

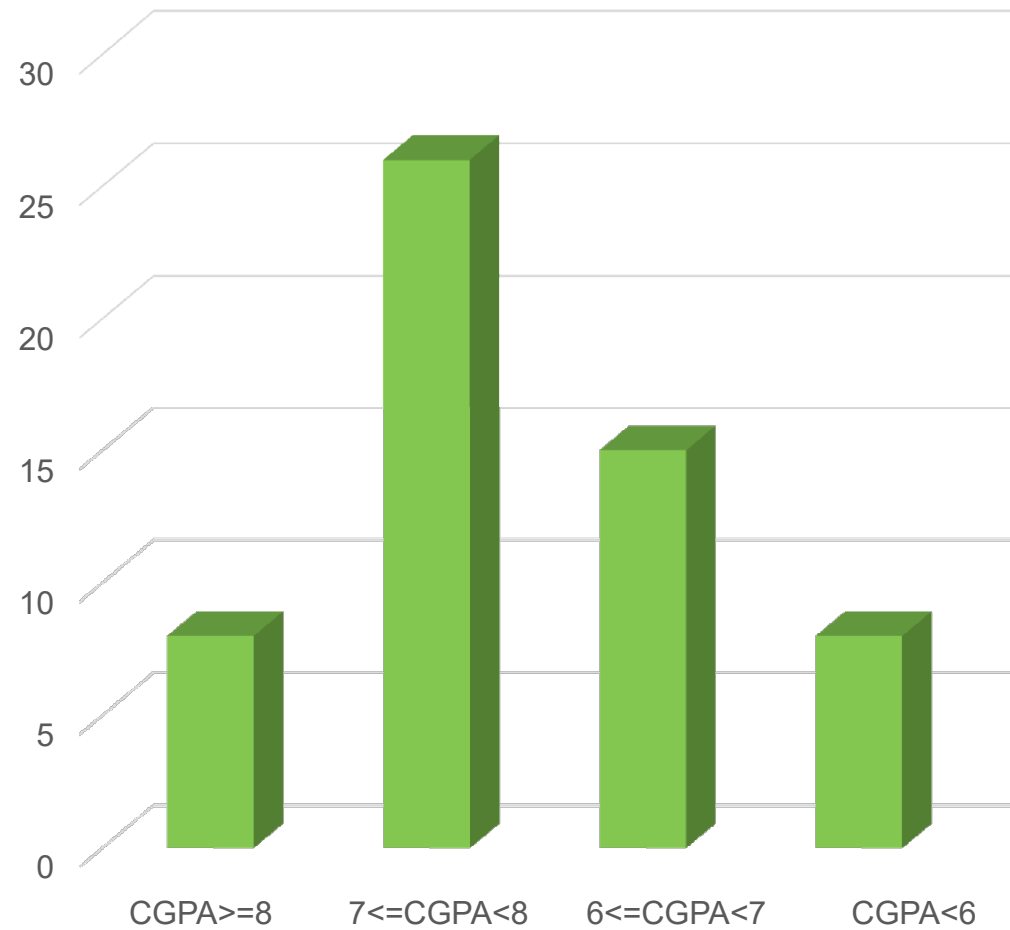


- The Department has two well-equipped labs at **Psychology Lab 1 and Psychology Lab 2**, and **Two Tutorial Rooms**.

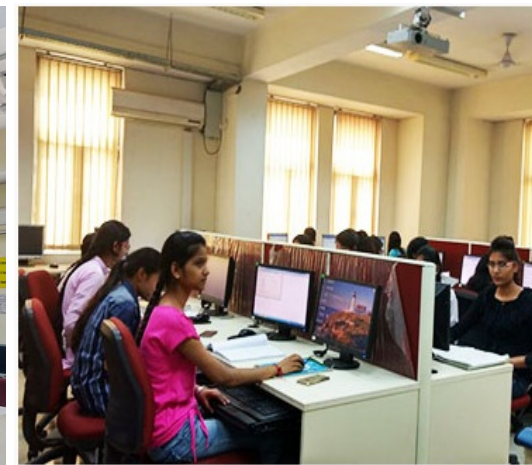
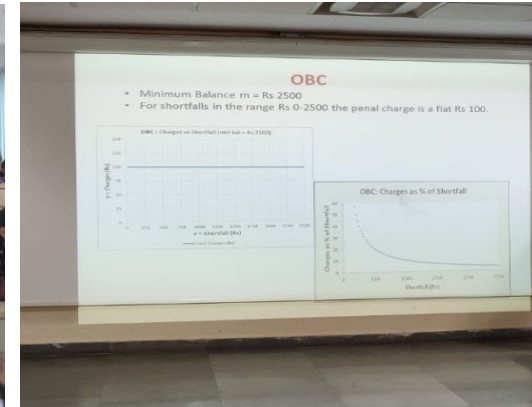
Department of Statistics has lecture rooms of good sitting capacity and one well equipped computer room namely Maths Lab1.

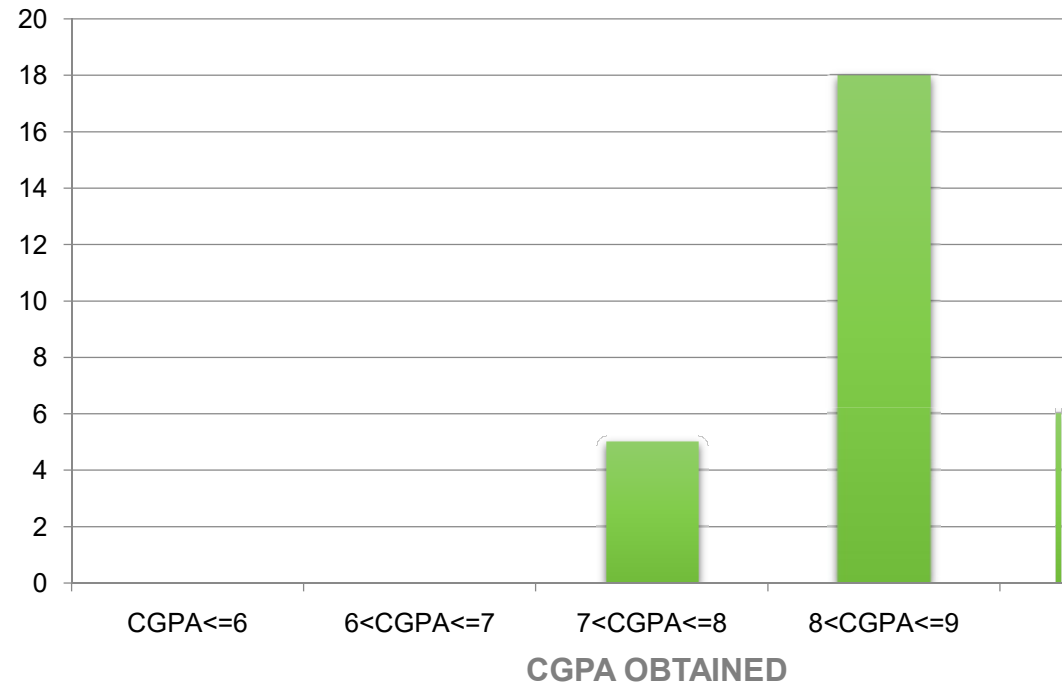

Developer Student Club

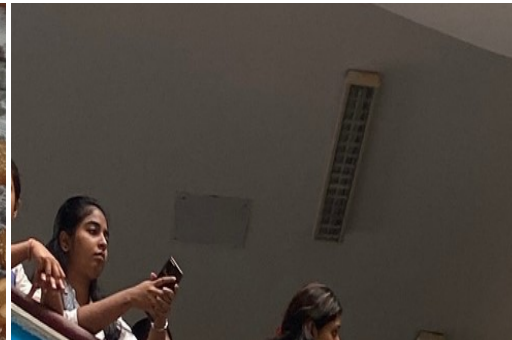
