FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

FOR ADMISSION 2020

General FAQs

Q. Should I follow a high rank college or prefer course over it?

Choose the course in the following scenario - Future Plans and Passion for Subject. While choosing a college, ensure - Similar Courses and Unclear Future plans. Make sure that the college or course you choose sync with your interests. You might not enjoy your college life if you end up choosing wrong course or college. It is important to match what you are getting with what you want.

Q. Do I need to fill the college form along with the centralised form of the University of Delhi?

Yes, you have to fill both the forms. Initially you have to fill the centralised form provided by the University of Delhi. After the cut off has been released by different colleges, you have to fill the form of college you are seeking admission in.

Q. What are the documents required at the time of submission of online form?

Following documents are required to be uploaded while submitting the form:

- 1. Passport size photograph of applicant.
- 2. Scanned signature of the applicant.
- 3. Self-Attested class X certificate/mark sheet containing Date of Birth of the applicant.
- 4. Self-Attested class XII mark sheet, if the results have been announced.
- 5. Self-Attested copy of the valid SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwD/KM/CW certificate, if seeking admission under any of these categories.
- 6. Self-Attested copies of Sports or ECA certificates as per the requirement.

The uploaded documents are required to be presented in the colleges as well at the time of admission for online verification.

Q. My result is yet to be declared; can I still submit an online registration form?

Yes, candidates can submit online Delhi University application form by choosing 'result awaited' option under the result section. However, they have to fulfil the minimum

eligibility conditions and meet the cut off list of that course/college during the stipulated period.

Q. Do Caste Certificates older than six monthswork or do they require a recent one?

The OBC applicants who belong to the 'Non-Creamy Layer' and whose caste appears in the Central List of the OBCs only, shall be eligible to be considered for admission under the OBC category (Validity period of OBC certificate in respect of 'non-creamy layer' status of the applicants as per DOPT Office Memorandum No. 36036/2/2013-Estt. (Res-I) dated 31 March 2016). The validity of the non-creamy layer certificate shall be for the financial year 2019-2020, issued on or after 31st March, 2020.

Q. Few students have dropped year twice after +2 for preparation for competitive exams? Are they eligible? what documents do they require as proof of drop years?

Applicants with gap year(s) will not be at any disadvantage for the purpose of admission to undergraduate courses. They should meet the requisite course-specific criteria for admission and must possess the necessary documents/certificates.

Gap year(s) will not be a bar for purposes of admission to the undergraduate courses.

Q. How Can I apply through ECA or Sports Quota?

Candidates need to fill an additional online application for DU Admissions 2020 if applying through ECA and Sports quota. For sports, three will be a centralized fitness test in the university. Then, for both sports and ECA, there will be trials in respective colleges.

Q. Is there any provision of financial assistance to students?

Yes, there is a provision. Needy and deserving students can avail the financial assistance through fee concession as per rules of Delhi University.

Q. Can I take admission in two different/same courses in different colleges after the declaration of a cut-off?

No, candidates cannot take admission simultaneously in two different courses or the same courses in different colleges. In case a candidate has taken admission at two places, the admission will be cancelled from both the colleges/courses.

Q. Once I have taken admission in a particular subject, can I change my subject during the course of study or after completing first year?

No, once you are admitted in a particular subject, you can change your subject only before the last date of DU admissions 2020, provided seats are available and you meet the requisite cut off.

Q. Does the college provide hostel facility?

Our college has on-campus hostel which accommodates about 120 students who are from outside Delhi. The college hostel gives students a neat, clean, and comfortable place to live in. It is only offered to the first-year students. Also, the accommodation will be offered on the basis of merit.

Q. What are my options if I don't get a hostel seat?

There are a lot of private PGs and hostels around the college, you can get accommodation there. However, the college is not associated with any of them and it will be the student's responsibility to find and get an accommodation there.

Q. What is Generic Elective paper?

Generic elective papers are offered to the students in semester I, II, III and IV. The GE papers are offered by various departments of the college. GE paper can be chosen according to your interest and in which you wish to enhance your knowledge. Ideally you should opt for a paper that supplements or strengthens your core specialization but *you cannot opt for a paper offered by your own course.*

Q. What is AECC paper?

AECC stands for Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course. It's a compulsory course as the name suggests. Now, there are two subjects under AECC in the first year i.e. English and Environmental Studies.

Q. Is it compulsory to take GE paper for all the students?

GE paper is compulsory for all students in 1st and 2nd Year of their graduation.

Q. Can the generic Elective be changed later when college starts?

Yes, it can be but it is generally decided by college.

Q. Is there a separate Physical Education Department in the college?

There is a separate Department with fully qualified teachers and coaches.
