*Caseniti*: A competition based on Mergers and Acquisitions. The competition was sponsored by Seek-A-Mentor and had over 800+registrations from all over India.



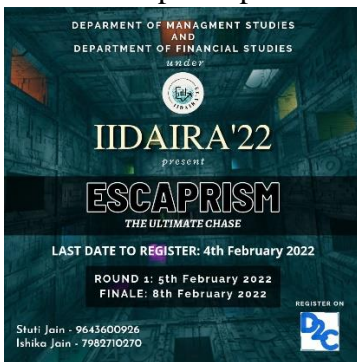
*Adept Allocator*: It comprised ideation of the product to be launched in the market, creation of logos and catchy taglines and working out a budget for the product.



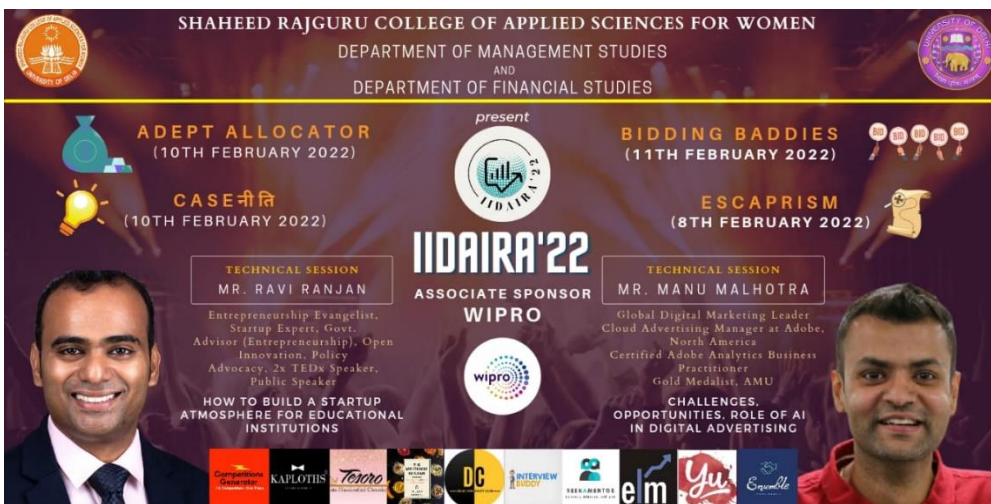
