3. Talk on "State of Education: Embracing New Technologies" on 26th October 2023.

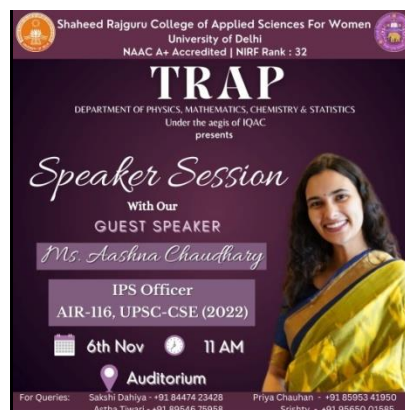
A talk on "State of Education: Embracing new technologies" was organised by the department, in its lecture series titled "Abhigyan".

A game “Human Calculator” was organised to celebrate Pi day by the department. Prizes were distributed to the winners.

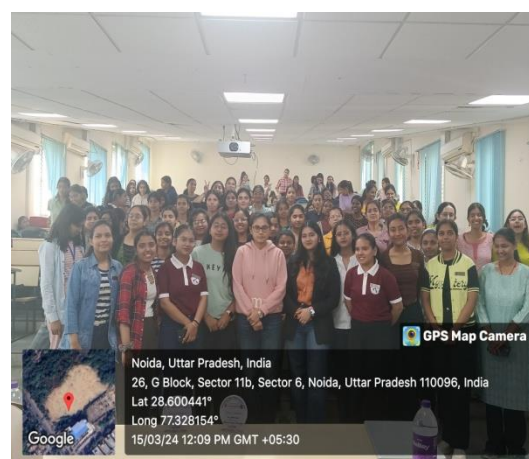
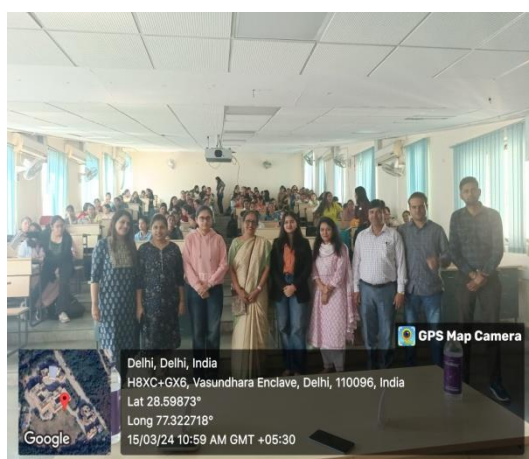
