Workshop on "Android Programming with Firebase": The Computer Science Department of Shaheed Rajguru College of Applied Sciences for Women organised a hands-on workshop on "Android Programming with Firebase" under the aegis of Harshit Dwivedi (Coding Blocks) on 29th August 2018. Harshit Dwivedi is a Google Certified Associate Android Developer and he mentored the students to develop their own Android Application with Firebase. We are in an era where Google's Android operating system has penetrated the nook and corner of the world and having its knowledge is essential. The workshop started with an introduction to Android Development and a step-by-step tutorial on how to use Android Studio for development. The workshop elucidated the basics of Android Programming and introduced the students to XML, various layouts, buttons and views that are used in Android. The students learnt about various Android Libraries like Picasso and Java classes like R and AppCompatActivity. Students were taught how to implement Firebase to their app, enable cloud messaging for sending notifications, add analytics to get insights of the app and to use Firebase as a real time database. The students were taught the nuances of developing their own apps and deploying them on to their phones. The workshop helped the students to hone their skills and equipped them with the latest technical know-how.


data analysis modules pandas, matplotlib and numpy. The workshop made an acquaintance with a programming language which was new to us and also it was too interactive.
