The following activities were carried out: Day 1- Poster making competition, theme: Beat Plastic Pollution, Jute Bags designed by students were presented to the judges of the Poster making Competition, Awareness program for Sanitary workers was carried out and the 5R's strategy to curb the menace of plastic pollution i.e. Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Replace was proposed. Day2- Awareness campaign for parents, teachers, students & Security guards and Pledge taking ceremony.

“The Department of Biochemistry” in our Institution has been following the plastic neutrality policy, “Say No To Disposables” since August 2017, the students were provided with ceramic cups by the head of the department (Dr Sadhna Jain) and no student uses any plastic cups, spoons or disposable water bottles.
