December:

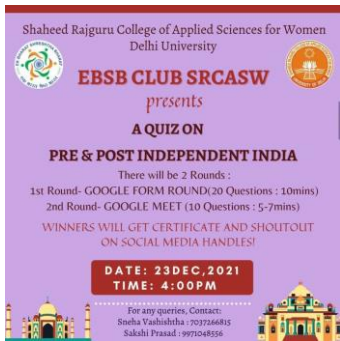

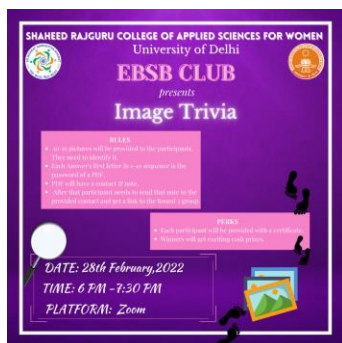


Image Trivia:
