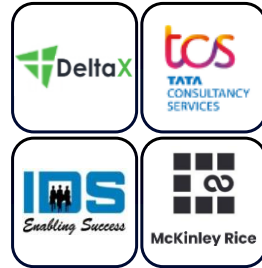
THE PLACEMENT CELL OF THE COLLEGE

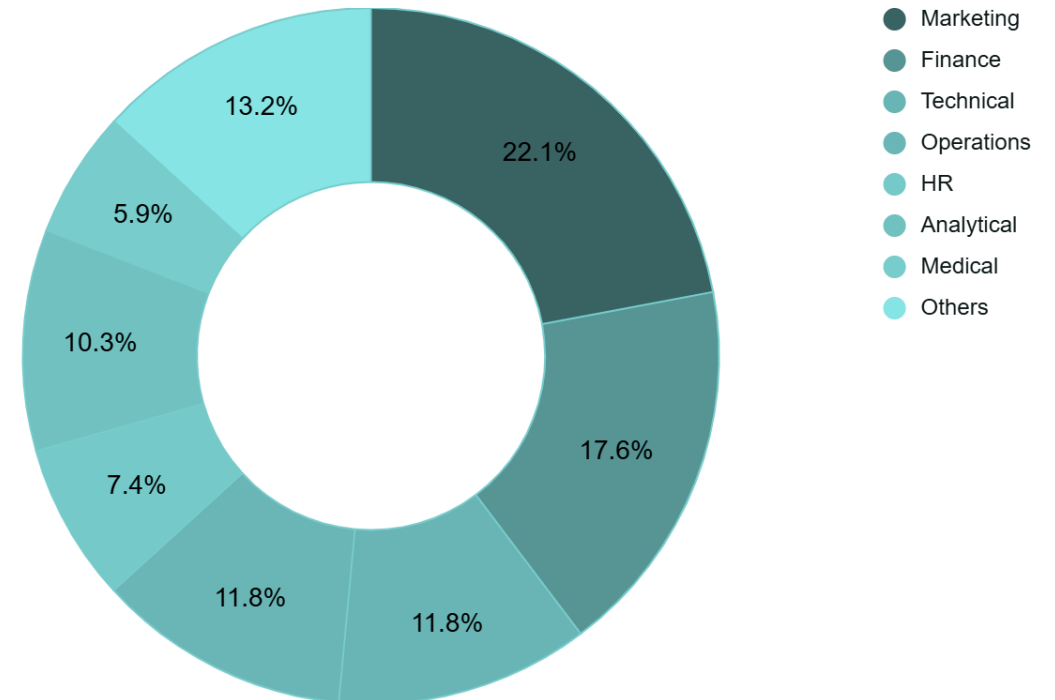

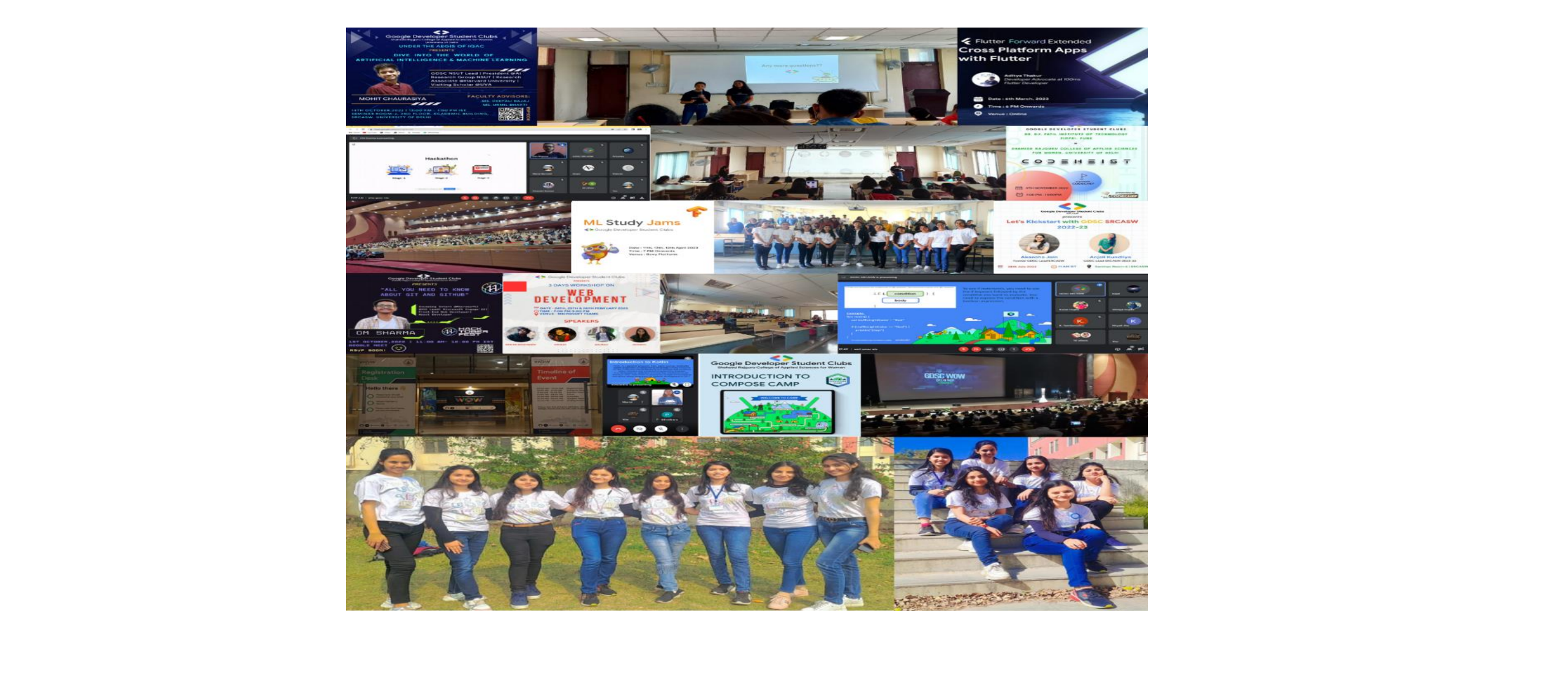
COMPUTER LITERACY PROGRAMME (CLP)

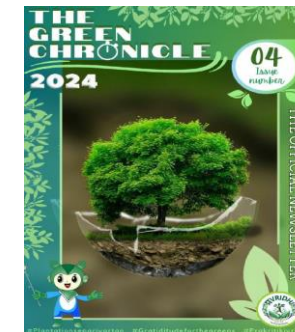

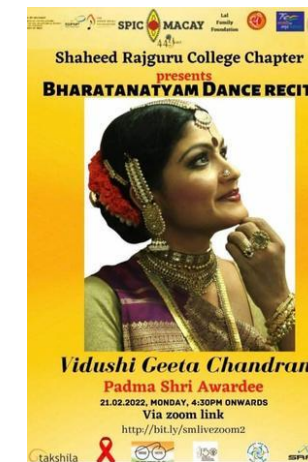
