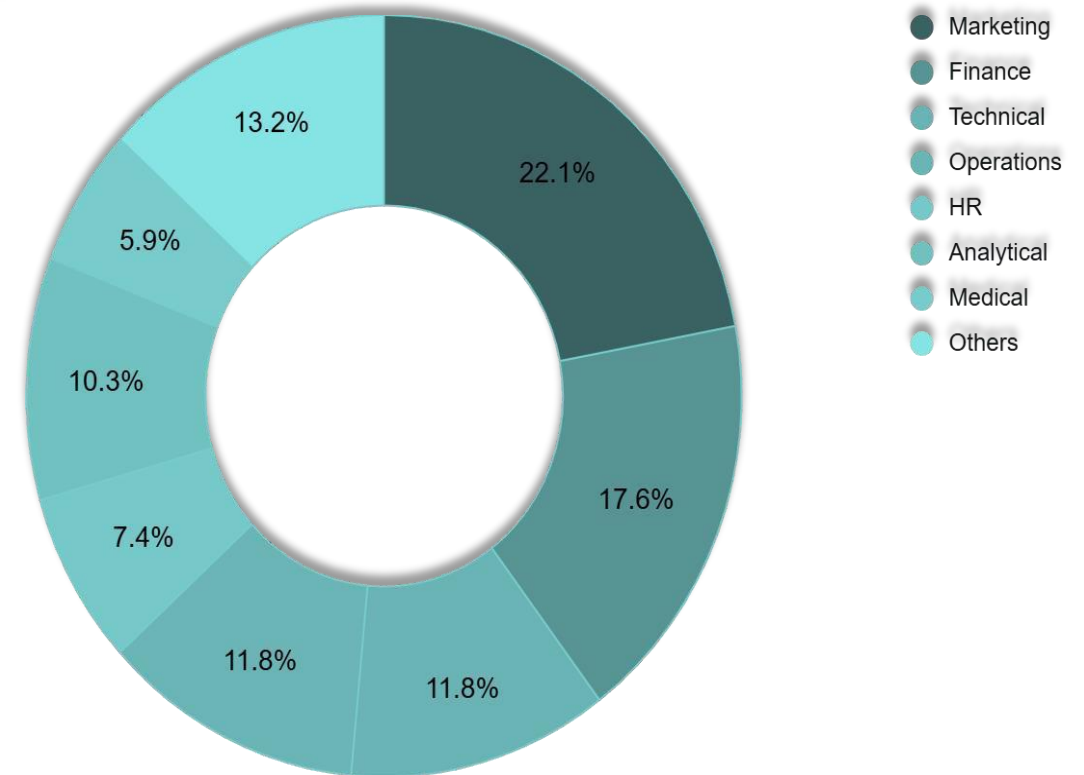

The Department of Electronics offers B.Sc. (H) Electronics, a degree program. This program provides in depth knowledge of basic to advanced electronics. The students have many avenues for higher education after completing this program such as M.Sc. (Electronics), M.C.A. M.B.A. etc. Students can have several carrier opportunities at the completion of this program. The department has well-equipped Laboratories namely Communication Electronics, Microprocessor, Optoelectronics, Digital and Analog Electronics etc. These laboratories are equipped with digital storage oscilloscopes, function generators, power supplies, multi meters, practical trainer kits, sophisticated microprocessor and microcontroller trainer kits etc. along with their software such as Matlab, Multisim, Xilinx, and LTspice. The two Electronics simulation laboratories are well equipped for online as well as offline simulations. For simulations, projects, assignments, webinars, and research the latest computers are also provided with internet facilities for students and staff to access the web. The department also has a book bank for faculty and students. The department actively organizes seminars, webinars, workshops, and training programs for students to streamline with the new developments and recent trends in electronics. The department has its student society named "Vidyut". This society along with the faculties annually organizes various technical and non-technical activities along with the technical fest "Electromania".

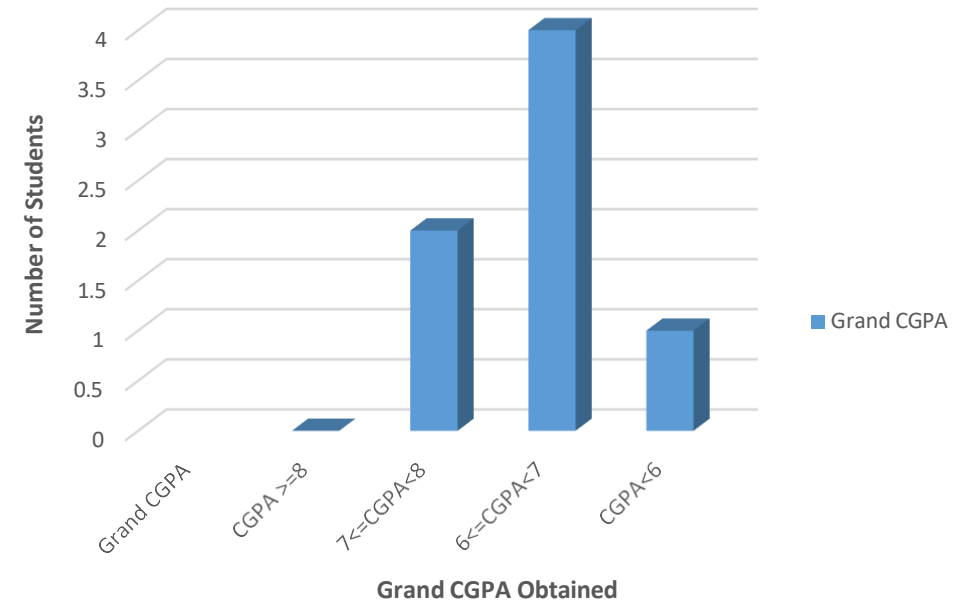

## Infrastructure

The Department of Instrumentation offers a B.Sc. (Hons.) program in Instrumentation. The department has developed a modern research facility and infrastructure to support teaching and research activities. The department is equipped with the following specialized laboratories:

- Analytical Instrumentation Laboratory (supported by a Wet Laboratory)
- Biomedical Instrumentation Laboratory
- Electronics Instrumentation, Electrical Machine, and Control System Laboratory
- Microprocessor Laboratory
- Industrial Instrumentation Laboratory (supported by a PCB Fabrication Laboratory)

The PCB Fabrication Laboratory is equipped with a semi-automatic CNC machine for precise PCB engraving and drilling, along with soldering stations and drilling tools for component mounting.

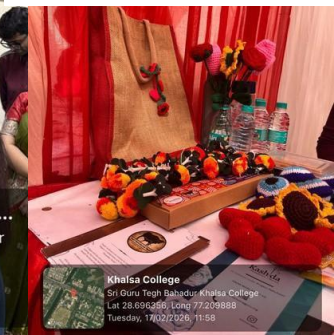


# ENACTUS
