1. Pledge Ceremony for the Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyaan

The event featured Mr. Amit Kumar Sharma, a nationally recognized expert in astronomy from the Nirbhaya Science Museum and the leader of the #NightSkyHunters team, who shared insightful perspectives on space exploration and astronomy.

5. Plantation Drive

On 30th August 2024 at 10:30 am, the NSS Unit in collaboration with Pravridhi, the Environment Club Society of SRCASW, organized a "Plantation Drive" under the national campaign "एक पेड़ माँ के नाम / Plant4Mother." This initiative, launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on World Environment Day, aimed to honour mothers by planting saplings and to promote environmental conservation and sustainability.

On **24th and 25th February 2025**, the **annual NSS fest**, Karvaan'25, held under AGASTYA'25, featured two engaging events. ACT FOR IMPACT was a reverse charades competition where teams of four acted out topics related to societal issues while other members guessed. TASK TRACKER GAME focused on real-time decision-making and strategic thinking, with teams of two completing various challenging tasks. In addition, a fundraising stall was set up, offering handcrafted bookmarks, tiaras, wall hangings and paper stones, with all proceeds dedicated to a charitable cause.



19. Cloth Donation drive

A six-day Cloth Donation Drive was held in the month of January, encouraging students and teachers to contribute clothing for the well-being of underprivileged individuals. The collected clothing material were distributed to those in need in a donation drive held on **March 18, 2025**.

22. Sustainability & Environment Conservation seminar

On **2nd April 2025**, the NSS Unit of SRCASW, organised a seminar in collaboration with "WEPLANT", a movement dedicated to addressing poverty, malnutrition, and environmental issues through seed banks and green restoration. The session emphasized the importance of seed conservation and plantation in restoring ecosystems and building a greener future. Ms. Aastha Maheshwari, the speaker for the session, spoke to the volunteers about the significance of seed plantation and its positive impact on the environment, particularly in combating deforestation and global warming.



23. Awareness Drive on Heat Wave Safety

On 11th June 2025, NSS SRCASW, under its "Beat the Heat" initiative, organized an Awareness Drive on Heat Wave Safety. Volunteers interacted with 2–3 vulnerable individuals in their local areas—such as watchmen, rickshaw pullers, vendors, and cleaners—to share vital information about heat waves. They discussed the health effects, signs of heat stroke, hydration tips, suitable clothing, safe timings to avoid sun exposure, emergency helpline (112), and general cooling methods to stay protected during extreme heat.
