
## NSS Report for 2015-16

Activities undertaken by **NSS Society** in academic session 2015-16 are as under:

**International Yoga Day** was celebrated on June 21, 2015 to bring awareness about health benefits of Yoga. Students and staff members enthusiastically took part in the yoga session organised by the college. Some NSS volunteers were selected for taking part in the celebrations held at India Gate.



**NSS Day Celebrations**were held onSeptember 24, 2015. Highlight of the day was Blood donation Camp organised in collaboration with Guru Tegh Bahadur Hospital, which was a great success. Besides that, poster making competition and slogan writing competition were arganized on tonics of Classifiness and Dangue suggests.





**Ektadiwas,** birthday of Sardar Vallabhbhai Pate Iwas celebrated on October 31, 2015. Article writing competition and rangoli making competition were organised to bring about awareness amongst students, the theme being 'National Integration'.

**Vermicomposting**: NSS Volunteers are striving to conserve the environment by collecting kitchen and garden wastes from college premises and eventually converting it into manure.



**Dengue Workshop**: Dengue workshop was organized on 23<sup>rd</sup> september'15. Five students from the college went to the NSS Centre, DU, North Campus. In workshop they were taught about the factors causing dengue mosquito to breed. The consequences of the same, how to avoid the breeding of this mosquito, what all Steps should be taken and all. The volunteers are asked to spread the word in the college premises and locality

**Collection Drive:** Collection drive for clothes, newspapers etc is organised by NSS volunteers from time to time. Winter clothes were collected and distributed to the needy in different slum areas.
