REPORT OF ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED BY NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS) IN THE COLLEGE

(2019-2020)

Yoga Day and Camp

NSS unit of SRCASW celebrated international yoga day and organised a Yoga Camp from 11th June to 21st June 2019 to encourage fitness and healthy lifestyle.

Swacch Bharat Summer Internship

NSS unit offered an internship opportunity to the volunteers for social work. Under the camp, students worked in Dallupura Village to help clean and maintain the hygiene of the village. The students interacted with the residents, visited the local school, and created a painting on the wall to deliver their message of health and hygiene.

Water Conservation Rally

The NSS unit organised a rally on the theme, "Water conservation". The objective was to sensitize the people on the importance of this priceless resource and to reduce its wastage.

SWACHHTA PAKHWADA

NSS unit of SRCASW observed the Swachhta Pakhwada (fortnight) from 1st August to 15th August 2019. This fortnight was observed to make an effort towards making India cleaner and healthier. Activities like campus cleaning, garbage collection etc. were held.

NSS ORIENTATION

NSS unit of Shaheed Rajguru college of Applied Sciences for women conducted its orientation programme and a talk on "preventive oncology" on 20th August 2019. In the programme students were briefed about NSS and what it is all. They were also enlightened about the different NSS drives, namely-Literacy, slum adoption, old age homes and orphanage visits, vermicomposting, cleanliness, collection and women upliftment. The NSS student council (2019-20) was also introduced in the orientation. Dr. Sushma Dhar MBBS (associated with Preventive Oncology Department of Dharamshila Cancer Foundation and Research centre), graced the programme by conducting a talk on "preventive oncology".

Medical Camp

NSS unit of Shaheed Rajguru college of Applied Sciences for women conducted a free medical on 21st and 22nd August in the college premises. Doctors from Dharamshila Cancer Foundation and Research Centre came and Eye Health came and set up their camp for medical and eye checkup respectively. There was blood pressure, sugar test and eye check available for the students and staff. A general physician was also there for the teachers and students to consult. There was ECG, Bone mineral density test and Pap smear test (only for married females above 30) available for the staff members. A gynecologist was also there for female staff to consult.

AIDS AWARENESS TALK AND ART COMPETITION

NSS unit of Shaheed Rajguru College of Applied Sciences for women conducted a talk and an "Art Work Competition" on 27th August 2019, to spread awareness about AIDS to celebrate International Youth Day as per the guidelines of Department of AIDS Control (govt. of India). The talk was conducted by Mr. Tyagi and Mr. Rajendra from Delhi Aids control society.

FIT INDIA MOVEMENT

The NSS unit and department of Physical Education of SRCASW jointly participated in the launch ceremony of Fit India movement by our honorable Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi at 10 AM on 29th August 2019. 10 students from NSS went to Indira Gandhi stadium, New Delhi to witness the launch live. Dr. Bimla Panwar, Assistant Professor in Physical Education and Sports also attended this program along with 12 sports students of our college at the honorable Vice Chancellor office. NSS students also watched this program through livestream in the college itself. Students also took a fitness pledge and promised to exercise and maintain their health.

EYE DONATION (NETRA DAAN) CAMPAIGN

NSS unit of SRCASW hosted an eye and blood donation awareness campaign in the college premises. This campaign was conducted by SAKSHAM (Samadrishti, Kshamata Vikas Evam Anusandhan Mandal) an affiliate of RSS. Donate blood in your lifetime and eyes after was the theme of the whole campaign. Students and staff were told about corneal blindness and how

donating eyes can be a blessing for someone. Everyone was also asked to fill a form pledging to donate their eyes after death and given a certificate for the same.

NO PLASTICS RALLY

NSS Unit of SRCASW conducted a "No plastics" rally on 20th September 2019, in and around the college campus. The rally was organized to discourage the use of plastics. Students conducted a rally on the same in and around the college.

ELECTORAL VERIFICATION

NSS unit of Shaheed Rajguru college of Applied Sciences for Women organized an Electoral Verification Program from 20th September 2019 to 23rd September 2019 in the college premises. The students enrolled themselves in the electoral verification program by creating their account on nvsp.in. Students were guided on the whole process and encouraged to register on the portal to apply for their own or family member's respective voter cards/get the corrections done in case of any error. Two guests from the election office also came to supervise and support the verification programme.

NSS Day

On the occasion on NSS Day, a best out of waste competition was organised for the college students on 24th September 2019. The objective was to showcase that even waste can be useful sometimes and thus, it has to be managed properly.

Anaemia awareness camp

A medical camp was organised in the college to raise awareness about Anaemia. Hemoglobin test was also conducted in college premises for staff and students to check their blood levels and ensure they are not anaemic.

Constitution Day

NSS unit of Shaheed Rajguru College of Applied Sciences for Women celebrated 70th constitution day on 26th November 2019 in the college premises. Students watched a live webinar from the college conducted by honorable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi. 


