## Report of activities conducted by Youth Parliament Society in the College

## (2019-2020)

On the occasion of Samvidhan Diwas (Constitution Day), the College, under the aegis of its 'Youth Parliament' Society conducted several activities on 26<sup>th</sup> November' 2019, to mark the Celebration of Samvidhan Diwas.

- 1. The Celebrations began with the students, teachers and the staff organizing a Pledge Ceremony. The Preamble to the Constitution of India was read by the students and staff.
- 2. A Pledge was taken upholding the Fundamental Duties of the citizens, as enshrined in Part IV-A of the Constitution. Pledges were recited in both Hindi and English. All the students, teachers and staff took a pledge to uphold the essence of the Constitution in letter and spirit.
- 3. At 1100 hours, the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Sh. Narendra Modi ji's interaction with the nation was telecasted and played Live in the College. The PM was addressing a Joint Session of the Parliament where he upheld the spirit and significance of the Constitution. The event was streamed Live for the students, teachers and para-teaching staff of the College.

4. The College invited an expert on Indian Constitution for a talk. Dr. Ritu Kohli, Associate Professor, Department of Political Science, Maharaja Agrasen College, University of Delhi was invited for a lecture on salient aspects of Indian Constitution, Fundamental Duties and Fundamental Rights. This was followed by an elaborate interactive session with students, faculty as well as the para-teaching staff of the College.
